The seeds are packaged in quantities usable by a home gardener before they are unviable. 2. There is no profit margin. 3. Store seed in a sealed container in fridge or cool place - not a garden shed or garage that can reach over 40° in summer. They will die.</p> <p>In paper bags - they are open to the air and can take up moisture and lose viability. So, pop the envelopes into glass jars or sealed plastic containers.</p> </div>
